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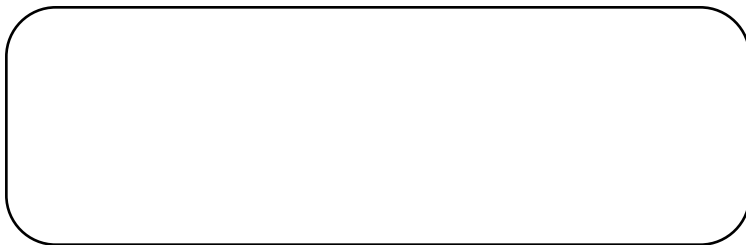

OKLAHOMA HAY REPORT
(09/09/09)

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay prices are steady and movement is slow. Mild temperatures prevailed over the state again this week. Scattered showers across the state along with high humidity have resulted in poor drying conditions for hay harvest. Producers are trying to prepare wheat seedbeds and put up alfalfa. Corn harvest is well underway and a few soybean fields have also been harvested.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Producers are trying to wrap up cutting and baling of grass hay, but high humidity and scattered showers have slowed down efforts.
