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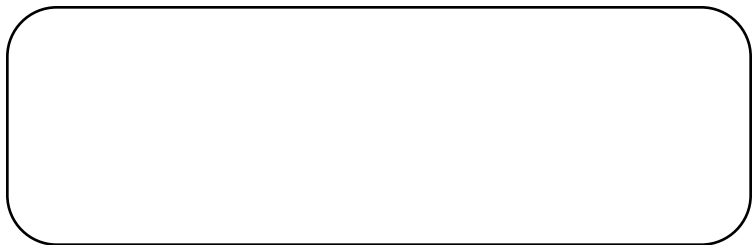

ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Cloudy wet conditions and cool temperatures have prevailed this past week over most of the state. Hay cutting and baling has been at a standstill due the wet weather conditions. Wheat planting will be in full swing as soon as the field conditions permit.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay prices are steady and movement is slow. Wet conditions have slowed grass hay baling, but is allowing pastures and meadows to make some good fall growth.
