ALFALFA HAY: Alfalfa hay prices are steady and movement is slow. Fall like conditions have prevailed this week across the state. Hay cutting and baling has been slowed due to the weather conditions. In areas that fields have dried enough wheat drilling has started. If dry conditions prevail over the weekend wheat planting will get underway at a fast pace.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Cooler soil temperatures have slowed rapid growth of grass in pastures and hay meadows. Producers looking for hay to purchase or have hay to sell can access the hay directory on the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture's website at www.oda.state.ok.us or call the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Hay Hotline at 1-800-580-6543.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 1.00 higher. Demand good for forward contracts. Late week cattle futures trading lower and farmers not interested in working a deal at the moment. Rain is still falling across the state as a low pressure system continues to pull moisture from the gulf. Cold front expected to move thru the state Monday evening. Highs are forecasted in the low 70's. Supply included 95 percent over 600 lbs; 63 percent heifers.

Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 5-10 cent slide on calves and 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
