Wheat planting is a little over 50 percent complete, with some areas to wet to plant and the extreme north-west to dry. Fourth cutting of alfalfa is over 90 percent complete.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Grass hay cutting is virtually finished for the season. Most areas appear to have an adequate amount of grass hay in storage at this point in time.
