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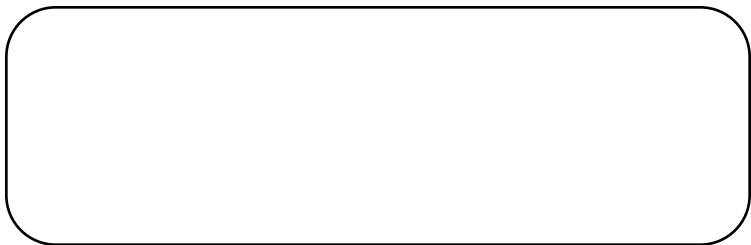

Demand moderate for feeder cattle following another week of declining cattle futures and boxed beef prices. Cash slaughter cattle prices followed and sold on a lower market as well with a little rebound late in the week. Dry weather early in the week allowed for some fast and furious wheat drilling as more rain moved in late in the week. Green bugs continue to be a problem on some of the early wheat. Supply included 92 percent over 600 lbs; 29 percent heifers.

Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 5-10 cent slide on calves and 3-6 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
