Rain has returned at midweek covering the entire state. These conditions will slow field work for several days as most all of the state received from one half inch to over three inches of rain.

GRASS HAY: Grass hay movement is slow and prices are steady. Most areas of the state have adequate supplies of grass hay in storage going into the fall.
