

Notice of Application to Organize a State Bank or Trust Company

Any interested person may submit to the Oklahoma Bank Commissioner at the Oklahoma State Banking Department, 2900 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, 73105, written comments or objections to the organization of the proposed (bank) (trust company), or a request for an opportunity to be heard, within 21 days after the first notice by publication as described in Title 6 O.S. § 306.1. Any request for an opportunity to be heard must set forth reasons justifying the time and expense entailed by such hearing. This application and any written comments or objections will be considered and processed pursuant to Title 6 O.S. § 301 et seq.

INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: Notwithstanding item 1 below, the applicant must not publish until notified by the Commissioner that the application has been accepted for filing!

1. Within 10 days after the Commissioner has received an application for filing, the applicant must publish notice of the filing in a legal newspaper of general circulation in the city, town, or county in which the proposed bank or trust company is to be located.
2. The Notice of Application (“Notice”) must be published on the same day of two (2) consecutive weeks and must contain a statement that an application has been submitted, the names of the organizers, the name and location of the proposed bank or trust company and the date on which the application was accepted for filing. (Refer to sample Notice provided)
3. The applicant must promptly furnish the Commissioner an affidavit evidencing such publication.
