



New Codes Adopted Effective July 1



Effective July 1, 2009, and thereafter, The Construction Industries Board hereby incorporates the

- International Plumbing Code/2009,
- 2009 International Fuel Gas Code, and
- the plumbing portion of the 2009 International Residential Code

as the minimum standard for the installation of plumbing in Oklahoma where no ordinance or regulation of a governmental subdivision applies.

Effective July 1, 2009, and thereafter, The Construction Industries Board hereby incorporates the

- International Mechanical Code/2009,
- International Fuel Gas Code 2009, and the
- International Residential Code/2009, Chapters 12 through 24)

as the minimum standard for mechanical work in Oklahoma.

Note: Political subdivisions may vary with respect to their code adoption and enforcement practices and may adopt standards more stringent than those contained in the statewide adopted code, it is advisable to check with the local jurisdiction where your work is located.
