The Oklahoma Department of Labor (ODOL) has determined that inflatable Zorb Balls (a/k/a Inflatable Spheres) fall under the inspection requirements of the Air Inflatable Amusement Ride/Device Inspection Criteria, minus the Tie Down and Blower sections. This criteria can be found on the ODOL's web site at www.labor.ok.gov.

Before the public may use the Zorb Balls (a/k/a Inflatable Spheres) they must be registered with the ODOL and an Oklahoma number assigned and affixed to each ball/sphere following completion of an ODOL inspection.
