

Proclamation

Whereas, the state of Oklahoma recognizes that no community is immune from natural hazards such as earthquakes, tornadoes, wildfires, floods, winter storms, drought or heat waves; and

Whereas, the unforeseen nature of earthquakes warrants Oklahomans to be continually prepared for such an occurrence; and

Whereas, responding adequately to earthquakes and other natural disasters depends on the preparedness levels of all participants in our communities - individuals, families, schools, community organizations, faith-based organizations, non-profits, businesses, and government; and

Whereas, the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management cooperates with other state and federal government agencies, including the Oklahoma Geological Survey, the Central United States Earthquake Consortium, local emergency officials and others to prepare Oklahomans for natural disasters, including earthquakes; and

Whereas, on October 15, 2015, at 10:15 a.m., Oklahoma joins other states in the Great Central US ShakeOut, a simultaneous, multi-state earthquake drill, designed to strengthen statewide and regional resiliency;

Now, therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor, do hereby proclaim October 15, 2015, as

"Great Central US ShakeOut Day"

in the state of Oklahoma.
