IMPORTANT INFORMATION – All questions on this form must be completed

Effective November 1, 2008 all non-resident applicants will be required at a minimum, to take the Oklahoma State portion of the examination. Oklahoma utilizes a national examination vendor (PSI, Inc) with 247 examination locations across the United States.

Have you been actively licensed as a sales associate respectively for a minimum of two (2) years out of the previous five (5) years? If you have not held an active license within the last five (5) years in another state, you must qualify through the procedures for a provisional sales associate and submit evidence of successful completion of ninety (90) clock hours of basic real estate. For additional non-resident licensing information see Commission Rules 605:10-7-9.

Will you be performing property management activities? YES NO

This is to advise that before you perform license activities in Oklahoma and/or receive commissions you must have been issued an Oklahoma non-resident license.

The non-resident license you are requesting will be issued to the address of your managing broker. Your managing broker must also be licensed as a non-resident in this State in order for you to obtain a license to operate in Oklahoma.

Requirements are also contingent based upon non-resident agreements which exist between states.
