SUMMARY

The Oklahoma Teachers Retirement System is seeking an Application Developer. This is a full time position in STATE GOVERNMENT and will be eligible for a generous total rewards package. Benefits include medical, dental, life, and disability insurance products as well as a defined benefit retirement plan, a deferred compensation plan and wellness program with financial incentive. Employees earn 3 weeks paid annual and 3 weeks sick leave in the first year as well as enjoy 10 paid holidays annually and longevity pay.

The primary responsibilities of this position include a thorough understanding of .Net C#-based software development and IIS administration. This environment also requires a demonstrated practical understanding of source control with application lifecycle management, ASP.Net and C#, software quality assurance, and operating within an Agile software development lifecycle. Ancillary duties require a practical basic understanding of SQL server database development, SSRS reporting, and HTML 5 and Responsive Design.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Writing object oriented C# code to support business needs in accordance with identified requirements, security standards, and coding best practices.
- Analyze and design program logic, screen layouts, reports and testing criteria to support development of browser based and thick-client applications.
- Develop or support database developers in complex Extract, Transform, and Load processes or complex stored procedures that support complex and mission-critical data aggregation and calculation processes.
- Participate in structured walk-throughs and other activities to review systems and provide training and support.
- Conduct or coordinate user acceptance, regression, and integration testing; make changes and corrections as needed.
- Maintain existing applications and provide support to end users and members of the public.
- Perform related work as required and assigned.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Bachelor's Degree in Management Information Sciences, Computer Science or an appropriate discipline from an accredited college, university, or career and technology center; and one year of experience in a related position; or
- An equivalent combination of education and experience.
