Adding “page fluffers” to the pages of a book provides an easy way for children with or without disabilities to turn pages.

Materials:

- Three-ring binder
- .5 mil lamination film or Kinko’s for lamination
- 1 copy of the book
- Rubber weather stripping

Directions:

1. Number the pages in the book; cut the book apart to separate each page.
2. Laminate each page of the story.
3. Three-hole punch each page and put it in the binder in order.
4. Cut the weather stripping into ½” chunks. Peel the backing of each piece and place three pieces on each page (front and back): one at the top, one at the bottom, and one in the middle at the outside edge.
5. Slide the cover of the book into the front of the binder and make a spine label.
