

Information Technology Accessibility Workshop

Oklahoma's Electronic and Information Technology Accessibility Law passed in 2004 (HB 2197) requiring state agencies, postsecondary institutions, and the State Board of Career and Technology Education to develop, procure, and maintain electronic and information technology that is accessible to people with disabilities. The Office of State Finance and the Department of Central Services issued standards and rules to implement the provisions of the law. The Office of State Finance IT accessibility standards became effective Sept. 8, 2005. The February 13-14, 2006 training opportunity provides information and technical assistance to those affected by the legislation. The presenters are national experts in the field of accessible electronic and information technology.
