Rehabilitating Oklahoma Farmers and Ranchers with Injury, Illness or Disabling Conditions Conference was held November 2-3, 2012, at the Oklahoma State University – Stillwater campus. Participants from across the state attended sessions regarding agriculture, farm tasks and disabling conditions; agriculture obstacles, safety and assistive technology; assessment tools; AT solutions; gerontechnology; AT funding options; documentation tips; and tours of machinery/equipment and swine research stations on OSU campus. Attendees also participated in case scenario assessments and provided presentations of their findings and recommendations. CEUs were awarded for OT, COTA, PT, PTA, and ATP certificates.

Sandra Stevenson, Oklahoma AgrAbility Program Manager and member of Oklahoma Agricultural Leadership Program-Class 16, toured the mid-southern region of Oklahoma including The Samuel Roberts Noble Foundation and OSU's Institute for Agricultural Biosciences. Educational presentations regarding Crisis in Agriculture, Marketing and Hedging, Technology to Assess Forage Mass, Feral Hog Trap Demonstrations, Pecan Orchard and Production, Cattle Handling Facilities/GrowSafe System and GrowSafe Beef, Past and Future Effects of Drought in Oklahoma, as well as tours of the Gene Autry Museum, Oklahoma Steel and Wire, Savage Equipment, and the Texoma Peanut Company also were attended.
