



T.C.'S STORY

T.C. experiences difficulty lifting, pulling and hitching his farm equipment due to a diabetes diagnosis and pinched nerves in his neck, which causes loss of control in his arms.

T.C's farm in southeast Oklahoma includes a hay business covering over 4,500 acres and a cow-calf operation with 150 cows. Approximately 8,000-10,000 bales of hay are sold from his farm to Braum's Dairy in Stonewall, Oklahoma. Naturally, with this size of operation, he is always on the go with little time for obstacles.

When physical pain began to decrease his productivity, T.C. joined forces with Oklahoma AgrAbility and the Department of Rehabilitation Services-Visual Services Division.

"DRS and AgrAbility could not have worked better together. They worked as a team and came out and actually listened to what would work and what wouldn't. They were real knowledgeable about the equipment and really understood what I needed," T.C. said.
