



## WILLIAM'S STORY

William's 80-acre property is in a remote location bordering a national forest in the southeast part of the state. He has been paralyzed for 15 years, and yet being in a wheelchair maneuvering the rough and rocky terrain can't stop him from managing an Ag business. He runs a longhorn cow-calf operation as well as breeding and selling horses and mules.

In addition, William seeds pastures with Bermuda, rye and a mix of both for grazing grass. He also clears cedar trees from the property, and continues to work with his table saw, drill press and jig saw to create children's riding rocking horses, rocking motorcycles, and rocking dinosaurs.

William worked with AgrAbility to connect with several resources. Together, they identified funding for assistive technology accommodations to his property and work truck.

A powered all-terrain scooter/wheelchair was also purchased to increase his safety and independence.
