Earlier this year, the CSBS Examiner Certification Committee announced the addition of the

new safety and soundness designation “Certified Senior Bank Examiner” (CSBE). The CSBE designation was developed for those examiners-in-charge who do not have supervisory and/or management responsibilities but would otherwise meet the requirements to upgrade to the Certified Examinations Manager designation. The CSBE credential recognizes the significant work experience and contributions of senior personnel who lead target examinations. A specialty certification, Certified Senior Trust Examiner (CSTE), was also implemented.

FDIC De Novo Bank Training

Assistant Deputy Commissioner Wayne Arbutnot and Regional Examiner Paul Qualls recently attended De Novo Bank Training sponsored by CSBS and the FDIC. Following an extended period without de novo activity, the training offered an opportunity to review the process for evaluating de novo applications for a charter and deposit insurance. The training also addressed changes in approach following the last period of significant new bank formation.

Application personnel from the FDIC, Federal Reserve, and OCC discussed topics including the application process, decision criteria for evaluation applications, and post-approval supervision. The training ended with an overview of all of the analysis that goes into an application.
