BOARD OF TESTS FOR ALCOHOL AND DRUG INFLUENCE**

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Pursuant to OAC 40:25-1-3, effective June 12, 2008, ( Oklahoma Register Vol. 25 Issue 18 June 2, 2008) the Board Of Tests For Alcohol And Drug Influence issues the following list of all simulators or reference methods approved for use in association with any breath-alcohol analysis apparatus, device, or instrument for the determination of the alcohol concentration of breath specimens approved for that purpose by the Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence, by resolution, at an open meeting of the Board:

- (1) Alcoholic Breath Simulator, Model Mark IIA, National Draeger, Inc., Pittsburgh, PA, or its predecessors or successors
- (2) Alcoholic Breath Simulator, Model 34C, Guth Laboratories, Inc., Harrisburg, PA, or its predecessors or successors
- (3) Alcoholic Breath Simulator, Model 10-4, Guth Laboratories, Inc., Harrisburg, PA, or its predecessors or successors
- (4) Alcoholic Breath Simulator, Model 210021, Guth Laboratories, Inc., Harrisburg, PA, or its predecessors.
- (5) Alcoholic Breath Simulator, Model 2100, Guth Laboratories, Inc., Harrisburg, PA, or its predecessors.
- (6) Pressurized gas cylinders containing a known breath-alcohol equivalent ratio of nitrogen and ethanol gas.
