The course will include 24 hours of lecture and “hands-on” lab, whereby the Chiropractic physician would receive classroom instruction in laboratory diagnosis of pathology as it relates to the use of injectable, nutritional substances, indications and contraindications including areas within risk management; OSHA requirements for your employees as well as public health concerns; technical instruction regarding proper injection techniques; and physically applying them (will require review of some anatomy); emergency procedures for shock; differentially diagnosing referred visceral pain from neuromusculoskeletal etiologies. Includes HO’s, slides, and video.
