Description of Amendment:

a. This is to incorporate the following:

Extend the General Solicitation Questions on Wiki period to May 10th
Extend the Solicitation Response due date to May 17th.

Question - Please provide the total number of users (staff function only) that would be accessing the system for the purposes of case management? Please provide breakdown by type of user/role: State Workers (OESC), Local Area Partners and Workforce Board Staff, others (accessing system only and not using the system for case management). Thanks.

Re:

- Number of staff users providing case management: approximately 500
- State workers (OESC): about 300
- Local Area Partners and Workforce Board Staff (including service provider staff): about 200
Others using the system (not for case management):
- Supervisors: about 80
- Eligible Training Providers: about 160
- Companies: approximately 10,000 in a year, but over 39,000 accounts in the current system (this does not count companies with jobs spidered into the system)
- Job seekers: about 190,000 in a year, however over 800,000 accounts in the current system

Question - What is the current total number of users registered to access AJILA system? Would the new system at deployment have the same or different number of users? Please provide expected total number of users to the best of your abilities. Thanks.

Description of Amendment - continuing

Re:

- **Current total number of registered users in the system: over 1 million. This number is a bit flexible as it depends upon how one counts users. Many staff have multiple accounts, job seekers can have multiple accounts; and companies often have multiple accounts. If one totals unique users (actual persons or companies), the number of user accounts will be less, but probably over 750,000.**
- **The number of users at deployment should remain the same as stated above with slight increases depending upon the length of deployment.**
 - **The number of staff users could potentially increase at deployment due to partnering in centers under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act by as much as 200.**

Question - Due to the Length of this RFP, and in order to provide the best response possible after questions are responded to, will an extension be offered on the submission date?
