1. Call Meeting to Order

Discussion: Director Brandon Clabes provided a written quarterly report, gave an oral summary of some of the highlights of the report, and answered questions posed by the members.

- Accreditation consultant has been advertised and will close March 18, 2022.
- Proposed changes have been made to some CLEET rules.
- Attended the OHP graduation in Oklahoma City.
- Met with Commissioner Tim Tipton, Public Safety Cabinet Secretary Tricia Everest, and Lieutenant Governor Matt Pinnell.
- Assistant Director Morrison and Field Representative Tami Terneus did an audit of a Reserve Academy.
- We are transitioning the Career Tech Basic Police Officer Program – Janey Rowden's division to oversee.
- Had comptroller from OSBI come to CLEET to audit our financial procedures. Received great feedback.
- Worked with John Parker, Finance Director, on CLEET budge overview for Governor Stitt's annual report.
- DOC has a new satellite coordinator, Brenna Whitford. DOC is requesting legislation to become an academy city.
- Earl Morrison, Preston Draper, and Director Clabes met with Commissioner Tipton and Major Brent Jones regarding reciprocity for OHP.
- Firearms policy has changed, first time in several years, and issued it statewide.
- Director Clabes and Preston Draper, General Counsel, attended legislative breakfast in Shawnee on February 11th.
- Finished the reconciliation of CLEET budget with Finance Director, John Parker.

7. Private Security Division Update

Discussion: Janey Rowden, Records and Licensing Manager, gave a summary of what is going on within the private security division.

- Application processing is running about 2 weeks behind due to the weather storms that took place in February.
- Kaitlyne Green is new to the department. We've welcomed her to a full-time position back in November 2021.
- Records and Licensing has started training for Thenthia.
- Shirley Todd, Receptionist, is the contact person for course numbers for mandatory and continuing education training that will be compatible with the new system.

Preston Draper, General Counsel, informed the committee of the following legislation bills.

- SB1370 – requiring certain training curriculum and requirements.
- SB80 – modifying requirements for unarmed security guards.
- SB1419 – modifying definition for private security; prohibiting certain interpretation; allowing certain carry for weapons.

8. Medical Marijuana

Discussion: Chairman Sen inquired about individuals working armed with medical marijuana cards after having taken calls.

General Counsel, Preston Draper, stated to look specifically at 63 O.S. § 425, in subsection B, which deals with state licensing issues. You may also want to look at 63 O.S. § 427.8, especially Subsections H and K.
