

SECOND ANNUAL "LAW ENFORCEMENT IN OUR SCHOOLS" TRAINING

Sponsored by CLEET, Oklahoma City Public Schools, Putnam City public Schools and hosted by the Moore/Norman Technology Center

On **July 27th and 28th, 2010**, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training, along with the Oklahoma City Public Schools, Putnam City Public Schools and the Moore/Norman Technology Center, will host the second annual "Law Enforcement in the Schools" training program. Last year the event was held in Broken Arrow and had over 150 participants from law enforcement and education.

This year's program will be held at the **Moore/Norman Technology Center South Penn Campus at 13301 S. Pennsylvania Ave., Oklahoma City**. Classes will be held both days from 8:30 - 5:00. *Continuing education credit will be given for both law enforcement and educators*. Courses are designed to inform school administrators, faculty, staff and law enforcement officers how to handle incidents occurring on school property where a police or security response is necessary. Goals are to develop understanding of the roles of both educators and law enforcement as they determine the best outcome for the students, faculty and staff that are impacted. Topics for the program include: Legal Issues; Drug Identification; Bullying; Media Response; Gang Intervention; Special Event Planning; Threat Assessments; Kinesics; and Students with Special Needs.
