“The Behavioral Analysis Interview Technique”

The Behavioral Analysis Interview Technique utilizes subtle, unconscious verbal and non-verbal behaviors of the interviewee to diagnose his or her emotional state, thereby providing the critical information necessary to get at the truth, and enable the interviewer to reach their goals faster and more thoroughly. With few exceptions, a person being interviewed will exhibit behaviors that indicate whether the person is being open and honest or evasive and untruthful. These behaviors will also reveal a person’s readiness to confess. In the Diagnostic Phase workshop, we teach how to recognize and evaluate the signs of concealed guilt. In the Interrogation Phase workshop, we teach how to use these behaviors in conjunction with a structured interrogation technique, to assist the person in admitting his or her guilt. Both phases are sometimes presented in a combined workshop.

The Behavioral Analysis Interview Technique will benefit anyone who attempts to gain truthful information, admissions and confessions from people who may be unwilling to supply it. The Behavioral Analysis Interview Technique will help you become a more effective interviewer, increase your admission and confession rate and maintain control of the interviews and interrogations. The majority of the interviewers who have attended these programs have reported an increase of at least 50% in their admission and confession rate when utilizing this technique.

We are offering this course for \$ 150.00 per officer and the class size will be limited.
