Bill To Watch

SB 567 requires every active, full-time peace officer certified by CLEET to attend and complete an 8 hour domestic violence and stalking course by January 1, 2016

This is not CLEET sponsored legislation.

Did You Know?

State law requires agencies to notify CLEET within thirty (30 days) if an officer resigns while under investigation.
