## Problem Solving Teams Training (TTEAMS)

### Course Description

Participants of the Tribal Community Police Problem Solving Teams Training (TTEAMS) will learn how to strengthen relationships between law enforcement, tribal agencies and the community. This training will demonstrate how community quality of life and safety can be enhanced through these partnerships. By working together, law enforcement and community members will be able to effectively address challenges by utilizing a team approach. The TTEAMS course curriculum will discuss:

- elements of change
- dynamics of group development
- building partnerships
- resource mapping
- overcoming barriers to working together
- creative solutions to problems

This two-day training is highly interactive and based on adult learning. TTEAMS is most effective when participants attend both days of training because each day consists of steps that build upon each other.

An additional element of TTEAMS is a component titled, **“Meth in Indian Country”** which focuses on the growing meth problem affecting many native communities. This session creates awareness of the significant challenges meth creates for law enforcement, first responders, treatment providers and the community as a whole.

The TTEAMS Training and Meth in Indian Country Program are currently being offered to 2008 Tribal Resource Grant Program (TRGP) grant recipients. ALL community members and dedicated professionals who may be interested in attending include:
