Registration forms can be made obtained by contacting Mike Adams, Guymon Police Department. Tuition for the course is \$325.00 per student. The tuition will cover manuals, and lunch while in the field.

PREREQUISITES:

Law Enforcement Officers **ONLY**

Prior certification in Basic Rifle Operator, or Tactical Rifle training preferred. If none, student must request a waiver and have it approved PRIOR to start of course.

LENGTH OF COURSE:

5 Days = 50 hours

Our Basic Sniper/Observer Course is the first of three courses designed to fully train the law enforcement sniper/observer team. Students should plan on an intensive 5 days that will start at 0800 and conclude no earlier than 1700. One evening will be devoted to night fire.

This information is strictly for law enforcement officers.

Requests for any information on our restricted training courses will require law enforcement employment verification.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Each student will be required to bring with them the following:

- Law Enforcement I.D.
 - **Body Armor**
 - BDU Shirt & Pants, no hunting camo
 - Boots
 - Sidearm pistol
 - 3 Magazines for above (Minimum)
 - 50 rounds sidearm ammo
 - **Rifle with Scope** .308 caliber only
 - **500 rounds** of Match Type Ammunition
 - Tactical Thigh Holster
 - Helmet (if issued)
 - Goggles or ANSI Approved Eye Protection
 - Knee Pads
 - Elbow Pads
 - Hydration System
 - extreme weather gear for heat or cold
- Cleaning kit for rifle and pistol
- Shooting Mat (if desired)
