## 6. Curriculum Review Board Composition

- O.S. 70-3311 B. 16. c. one member shall represent a county jurisdiction with a population of fifty thousand (50,000) or more and who shall be a management-level CLEET-certified training officer. The term for this position will be three years.

- O.S. 70-3311 B. 16. d. one member shall represent a municipal jurisdiction with a population of less than fifty thousand (50,000) and who shall be a CLEET-certified training officer. The term for this position will be two years.

Mr. Maile stated the CRB meets six times a year at CLEET.
