Shannon Butler, Training Manager, explained that LASER is a supplement for ALERRT. It was modified by National Center for Biomedical Research and Training (NCBRT) for CLEET. It has been condensed from 16 hours to 8 hours in order to be able to teach this curriculum in the Basic Academy. LASER allows enough time to run the majority of cadets through scenarios, while the remainder of the cadets watch and learn. In addition, LASER covers stairwell training where ALERRT does not. It is not the full level of ALERRT, but gives the basic foundation to basic academy cadets. ALERRT will still be offered as a continuing education class.

Chief Sweger made the motion to accept the LASER curriculum and begin teaching it in the Basic Academy. Lt. Lance Arnold, Norman Police Department, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
