## ***2. Approval of Minutes***

Action Taken: The minutes of July 14, 2016 meeting were reviewed by the Board Members. Mr. Wall made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Mr. Baldwin seconded the motion. Mr. Baldwin voted yes; Mr. Barlow voted yes; Chairman Rivers voted yes; Mr. Terrell voted yes; Mr. Wall voted yes. Motion passed.

## ***3. 40 Hour Mandatory New Handler Course.***

The members had a lengthy discussion with Director Emmons, in reference to criteria for the 40 hour course. Director Emmons stated that he has researched canine certifications in other states through members of IADLEST. Iowa has a process in place that is similar to Oklahoma. Some states do not have Narcotic Dog Team certifications. Director Emmons stated that he will present the Drug Dog Advisory Council's ideas/wants to the CLEET Council. The discussion progressed to Chairman Rivers stating that it may be easier to add a recommended 40 hour handler course to the Oklahoma Drug Dog Standards and Guidelines. Chairman Rivers also stated that he has a CLEET accredited 40 Hour Basic Handler Course, and that he would be willing to share his material with other instructors, so that more courses could be held.

Action Taken: Mr. Baldwin made a motion to add that a "40 Hour Handler's Course" was recommended, to the Oklahoma Drug Dog Standards and Guidelines. The motion was seconded by Mr. Terrell. Mr. Baldwin voted yes; Mr. Barlow voted yes; Chairman Rivers voted yes; Mr. Terrell voted yes; Mr. Wall voted yes. Motion passed.

## ***4. Meeting Dates for 2017.***
