2. Approval of Minutes.

Mr. Baldwin asked if he could research this problem and bring back the information at the next meeting. Chairman Rivers agreed this was a good idea.

Members then had a general discussion about various other issues associated with canine licensing.

Chairman Rivers said he had talked to Director Scully, OBNDD, about moving the canine certification to that agency but had not received an answer. He asked that Director Emmons call Director Scully.

Chairman Rivers also reminded members to review the standards and guidelines regularly for changes.

Mr. Baldwin asked Ms. Shivers if she could help him find out how many dual handlers there are in the state.
