CLEET's Chief of Operation's Chris Sutterfield stated that CLEET would have the information available on the website, and forward it on to Oklahoma Chief's Association, and Oklahoma Sheriff's Association.

Travis White, Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics, spoke briefly about the upcoming A-One Conference. He distributed a hand out titled , Legal Issues Relevant to Drug K-9's.
