NEW MANDATORY CLEET ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS (HB1084) EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2009

Effective November 1, 2009, any person who is employed as a peace officer in Oklahoma and who is scheduled to attend a CLEET basic law enforcement academy in Ada, Oklahoma must:

1. Within ninety (90) days of hire and prior to CLEET admission, be required to score a minimum of 70% on a reading, writing and comprehension examination approved and administered by CLEET; and
2. Prior to CLEET admission, provide proof of a score of a minimum of 70% on the CLEET approved physical assessment test; and
3. Upon employment and prior to CLEET admission, execute a promissory note payable to CLEET for reimbursement of training expenses if the Peace Officer leaves the law enforcement profession within four (4) years following graduation from CLEET.
