

NOTICE

On February 12, 2021, Governor Stitt issued Executive [Order 2021-07](#), which ends the basic training deadline waiver that was adopted at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. The provision waiving the six-month basic training requirement will now end on March 12, 2021. In other words, beginning March 13, 2021, all persons employed as peace officers must be certified as peace officers within six months of the date of employment or have received a training extension from CLEET based on good cause and in compliance with CLEET rules.

Agency heads who have questions about specific circumstances should reach out to CLEET for guidance on how to comply with training requirements.
