1. Call Meeting To Order

Chairman Price called the meeting to order at 10:00 am. Roll was taken. Mr. Louis Maltos, Mr. Bill Howard and Mr. Rick Van Auken were absent. A quorum was present.

2. Approval of Minutes

The committee reviewed the minutes of the March 6, 2014 regular meeting.

Action Taken: Mr. Wayne Pauley made a motion to approve the information as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alan Grayson. A vote was taken. Chairman Bill Price voted yes; Mr. Wayne Pauley voted yes; Mr. Alan Grayson voted yes. The motion carried unanimously 3-0.

3. Legal Update on Private Security Complaints

Mr. James Wilson advised the committee there have been 38 new complaints in 2014 and since the last meeting 21 have been filed; 129 are still pending and 38 have been closed. Mr. Wilson wanted to make the committee aware of a hearing with the Administration Law Judge, Jan Presler involving a deferred sentence. The state law and statute the court dismisses without a finding of guilt; it is not considered a conviction. Mr. Wilson explained he advised the former Director the CLEET rule was no good because if the rule contradicts the statute the statute supersedes. Mr. Wilson is submitting a new statute next year unfortunately it is too late to submit this year. The process will require statute changes therefore requiring the entire process through legislature. His suggestion will be to add disqualifications for any plea other than not guilty.

Action Taken: Mr. Alan Grayson made a motion to approve the information as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wayne Pauley. A vote was taken. Chairman Bill Price voted yes; Mr. Wayne Pauley voted yes; Mr. Alan Grayson voted yes;. The motion carried unanimously 3-0.

5. Update on Private Security Curriculum

Chairman Price presented the information to the committee via notes from Tom Marshall. Mr. Marshall states he is receiving responses from the people he reached out to regarding the curriculum update. Chairman Price will have a copy for each committee member prior to the next meeting for them to review and be ready to review and vote during the September 18, 2014 meeting.

6. Executive Director Update

Executive Director Emmons stated regional meetings have started around the state that he has been in attendance. He also attended a National Conference interacting with other State Agencies. The main topic was accepting more military training for required training. Director Emmons advised they added language to Bill 1474 the OK Private Security Act regarding training records and current address information which is included in Title 59. This bill will now affect Peace Officers working in the capacity of a Security Guard and violates

any rules under Title 59 CLEET can take administrative action against the Peace Officer Certification.

Director Emmons advised the committee the Fall Training Initiative is being held September 8 -12 at the Gordon Cooper Technology Center in Shawnee and Private Security will have classes towards required continuing education.

Director Emmons advised CLEET opened an office in Claremore with a Field Rep manning the site and CLEET was holding their first reserve academy. There will be an office opening in Oklahoma City and will be manned by Norma Floyd two days a week sometime in July. At this point no applications can be delivered to this address due to deposit restrictions and the rules state money has to be deposited daily.

Action Taken: Mr. Wayne Pauley made a motion to approve the information as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alan Grayson. A vote was taken. Chairman Bill Price voted yes; Mr. Wayne Pauley voted yes; Mr. Alan Grayson voted yes; the motion carried unanimously 3-0.

7. CLEET Legislative Update

Director Emmons spoke of the legislative closing and the bills CLEET submitted this session. The first bill 1407 changed the language for those people submitting payments changed to remitter.

Refund requests for anything other than a denial shall be submitted in writing within six months of the date CLEET receives the payment.

Senator Shorty ran a bill that was shot down in the House regarding Private Security funds be kept with CLEET in the Revolving fund. The house brought back under HB3531 effective November 1, 2014 that all Private Security license fees will be kept at CLEET in the Private Security Revolving fund while no funds will go towards the General Fund.

Action Taken: Mr. Wayne Pauley made a motion to approve the information as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alan Grayson. A vote was taken. Chairman Bill Price voted yes; Mr. Wayne Pauley voted yes; Mr. Alan Grayson voted yes; The motion carried unanimously 3-0.

9. Reappointment of PSAC Member

Natalie Johnston informed the committee The Council reappointed Mr. Bill Howard, Mr. Louis Maltos, Mr. Bill Price and Mr. Rob Vincent. Mr. Rob Vincent resigned prior to the March 6, 2014 meeting. Ms. Johnston advised committee there is a vacancy for his chair. All current members have been reappointed until 2017.

Action Taken: Mr. Alan Grayson made a motion to approve the information as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wayne Pauley. A vote was taken. Chairman Bill Price voted yes; Mr. Wayne Pauley voted yes; Mr. Alan Grayson voted yes;. The motion carried unanimously 3-0.
