

Active Threat Assessment Training for Law Enforcement (Online)

Threat Awareness for Law Enforcement is a multi-course, research-based, on-demand training program that provides learners with knowledge, tools, and techniques to identify and assess active threats.

Through the active threat assessment methodology, learners are trained to:

- Systematically observe any environment
- Identify potentially threatening individuals and situations
- Assess threat levels using visible behaviors.



OBJECTIVES

By the end of the program, learners will have a working knowledge of the terms and concepts associated with active threat assessment and be able to:

- assess a behavioral baseline using the Behavioral Baseline Instrument (BBI);
- identify the roles, deviations, and objectives of those they are observing;
- identify behavioral threat indicators and their relevance to the baselining process; and
- identify a Person of Interest (POI) and recognize a potential threat.

The *Threat Awareness for Law Enforcement* Program is certified by the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training (IADLEST) through their National Certification Program.



BACKGROUND

These techniques were developed through research with law enforcement officers from throughout the United States and were validated by Social Scientists under the auspices of the Just Doesn't Look Right (JDLR) Project. The JDLR Project was supported by the Rapid Reaction Technology Office of the U.S. Office of the Secretary of Defense.

ONLINE FORMAT

The online program consists of five courses; an initial package of four courses plus a refresher training. Our system will save learner progress allowing the program to be taken over time. All courses are self-paced and include a mix of lectures, videos, and video-based exercises.



Threat Observation

In *Threat Observation*, learners are trained to systematically observe any environment using our baselining process. (Certificate of Completion Provided)



Threat Observation Refresher

Course 2 is a short review on key concepts from *Threat Observation* that allows learner to bridge systematic observation and the visual cues in the next course.



Course 3: Threat Indicators

In Course 3, learners are trained in visual cues that indicate a person may be conducting surveillance, preparing to attack, or carrying a weapon.



Course 4: Practice & Final Exam

In Course 4, learners merge their skills from Threat Observation and Course 3 and complete an interactive final exam to assess their active threat assessment skills. (Certificate of Completion Provided)



Threat Awareness in Practice: A Refresher Training

In this refresher course, learners review course concepts and practice the skills learned in the initial four courses. Enrollment is processed 6 months after completion of Course 4. (Certificate of Completion Provided)

EXAMINATIONS & COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

There are three theory examinations and three practical examinations. An 80% average score is required to complete the program. We use iterative and compounding practice exercises and material to meet objectives. A certificate is provided after completion of Course 4, and *Threat Awareness in Practice*. Downloadable course materials are provided and learners have access to the program after completion.

PRICING
