### 6. Making Marijuana Optional

**Discussion:** David Rivers stated that even with 788 passing, nothing has changed in terms of interdiction. Some departments will continue to run four odor dogs. Other departments are wanting to purchase and run three odor dogs. Rivers stated that he researched other organizations to see how they are handling the changes taking place. All of the ones he researched decided to make Marijuana option on the K9 team certifications. Guests Ron Walker, Rogers Co. SO; Michael Griffin, Tulsa PD; Ryan Woods, Tulsa PD, and Jeremie Miller, Moore PD requested to speak and all agreed they would like Marijuana to become optional. Marque Baldwin agreed that it should be optional with the choice to go to four odors later if the handler chooses to.

**Action Taken:** David Rivers made a motion to make Marijuana optional for K9 certifications and update the Drug Dog standards and guidelines to state the below. Marque Baldwin seconded the motion. David Rivers voted yes. Anthony Moore voted yes. John Terrell voted yes. Doyle Tosh voted yes. Marque Baldwin voted yes. Motion carried 5-0 Items will be sent to the CLEET Council for approval at the October 31, 2018 meeting.

Current: Title 3 Target Odors for Certification

New: Title 3 Target and Optional Odors for Certification

Current: 3.2 Marijuana minimum amount to be used 10 grams, maximum 50 grams.  
New: 3.2 Optional target odor of marijuana minimum amount to be used 100 grams.

Current: Title 6, (6.12) Failure to find the minimum hidden four target odors will result in failure to certify the team.

New: 6.12 a. Failure to find the minimum hidden target odors consisting of cocaine, heroin, and methamphetamine will result in failure to certify the team.

6.12 b When choosing optional odors, failure to find the minimum hidden optional target odors will result in failure to certify the team.

## **7. Muskogee PD, Officer William Peters is requesting to be an Evaluator.**

**Discussion:** Officer Peters was not present and did not have a representative present at the meeting. Anthony Moore stated that he has spoken with Officer Peters and attended a basic K9 course he taught. Anthony Moore states he is very knowledgeable.
