HAIR SHAPING/CUTTING (MEN'S TAPER CUT/LAYERED TOP) (30 minutes)

Pre Cut Check - Examiner will determine if the men's taper cut was cut in the taper prior to exam.

Taper Cut - Candidate is to demonstrate proper use and handling of clippers and comb on the back section (nape to occipital bone) of the hair/head and sides cutting at least ¼ inch of hair, demonstrating a definite degree of elevation in the haircut using the clipper. **(No guards or switching out of metal clipper blades)**

Blending- Candidate is to demonstrate proper use and handling of scissors/shears on the remainder of the hair/head. Hair cut can be blended with the shears or clippers. (Cut at least ¼ inch)

Hair cut check/thinning shears (candidate will check hair cut) - Examiner will ask each candidate to demonstrate hair cut check procedures. Examiner will ask each candidate to demonstrate proper use of thinning shears.

TAPER BACK- Uses clippers to establish graduated haircut with no blocked line (taper/fade) from nape to occipital bone

PERMANENT WAVE**(15 MINUTES)****(Mock procedure –without application of wave solution)**

Candidate is to do a chemical two (2) towel drape (for all chemical procedures). Candidate is to sufficiently wet hair with water, section into six (6) sections. Wrap/roll ½ on ½ off base, a total of 6 perm rods in the crown section of the head (2 white, 2 grey, and 2 pink full length rods).



SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR THE BARBER EXAMINATION

Candidates will need two manikins or one manikin and one model.

One (1) manikin/model appropriate for men's taper cut with layered top

One (1) manikin with 4-6" length hair for permanent wave and the four (4) chemical services

STATION REVIEW:

Surface wipes or surface sanitizer

Surface towel

Hand sanitizer

Spray bottle with water

Large trash bag

HAIR SHAPING/CUTTING (MEN'S TAPER CUT/LAYERED TOP)

Towel/neck strip

Cape

Utility/clipper comb

Clippers (no guards)

Shears /Scissors

Thinning shears

CHEMICAL DRAPE/PERMANENT WAVE

Manikin with 4-6" length hair

2 Towels (for chemical drape)

Chemical cape

End Papers

Perm Rods (2 white (large), 2 grey (medium), 2 pink (small))

Utility/Tail Comb

Clippies/Clamps

CHEMICAL SERVICES

Chemical Relaxer Retouch with Smooth Down

Bleach Lightener-virgin hair application procedure

Tint to Dark-virgin hair application procedure

Bleach Lightener-re-touch procedure

Disposable Protective Gloves

Tail/utility comb(s)

Clips/Clamps

Spatula

Chemical Brush and Bowl (two (2) of each) One bowl/brush for cholesterol cream and one bowl/brush for gel

Cholesterol cream (relaxer/bleach re-touch)

Colored setting gel (virgin bleach, tint to darker)

Applicator Bottle (optional)

Each candidate will need two manikins. One manikin with at least 4-6" in length for perm and chemical applications and one manikin for the men's taper cut (hair should be longer on top for the layer portion of the cut) **A MODEL MAY BE USED FOR THE MEN'S TAPER CUT**

Candidates can pack for each category and place supplies in clear plastic baggie with a category label on the outside of the baggie.

Water bottle, hand sanitizer and one towel may be left out at all times and re-used as needed.

Cholesterol, gel, chemical brush and bowls can be used for all chemical applications. Candidate does not have to switch out these items for each chemical. Candidates do not have to re-drape or re-glove. Chemical drape will be for all chemicals.
