APPRENTICE APPLICANT AFFIDAVIT

No person shall be issued a license as a barber apprentice unless such person is at least 16 years of age, and works under the direct supervision of an Oklahoma licensed barber who has at least 2 years of practical experience as a licensed barber. Persons applying for this license should have intentions of registering for the State Barber Examination upon completion of the required 3,000 clock hours.

NOTE: The barber apprentice shall notify the Board immediately when changing shops or supervising barbers. An apprentice may transfer to another establishment by requesting a new license application from the Board. The application must be filed and approved by the Board before the transfer will be authorized. In addition, the original apprentice license must be returned to the Board before the transfer is complete.

Effective July 11, 2008, the barber apprentice license is valid for two years from date of issue and may not be renewed. The supervising barber and the apprentice barber must arrange their schedules for the apprentice barber to obtain a minimum of three thousand clock hours as a licensed apprentice within the two year time frame. Hours cannot be completed in less than eighteen months. If the apprentice does not complete the minimum three thousand clock hours within the two years, the apprentice must attend a license barber college to meet the requirements to sit for the State Barber examination. We suggest that each apprentice obtain the "Milady's Standard Professional Barbering" textbook at the beginning of apprentice training.

If an apprentice ceases training prior to completion of two years, the supervising barber shall notify the Board in writing within fourteen days and return the apprentice license, along with any quarterly progress reports and weekly time sheets not previously submitted.
