**FY 2010 National Criminal History Improvement Project (NCHIP) Grant Award**

The purpose of the National Criminal History Improvement Grant is to assist states in meeting various evolving federal and state requirements regarding criminal history and related records.

In 2010, the NCHIP grant award is a competitive grant process. The Oklahoma District Attorneys Council received one of the few federal awards because of the project's focus on the exchange of data between law enforcement and the Courts.

*Grant funds will be used to establish the infrastructure to enable the Oklahoma District Attorneys Council (DAC) to participate in the Administrative Office of the Courts' Integrated Justice Information System (IJIS) initiative. Specifically, DAC will implement an infrastructure that will provide the mechanism by which the agency can participate in the electronic exchange of information from the IJIS messaging system, and load information into the JustWare case management system (CMS) automatically, thereby eliminating the manual entry of the data. This will improve both the accuracy and timeliness of the data entry.*
