FY 2012 Sexual Assault Services Program Grant Awards

The purpose of the Sexual Assault Services Program Grant is to provide intervention, advocacy, accompaniment, support services, and related assistance for adult, youth, and child victims of sexual assault, family and household members of victims, and those collaterally affected by sexual assault, except for the perpetrator of such victimization. Examples of eligible services may include: crisis intervention, accompaniment to court, individual and group support services, information and referral, and, the development and dissemination of materials.
