FY 2014 Justice Assistance Grant- Local Law Enforcement

The purpose of the 2014 Justice Assistance Grant – Local Law Enforcement (JAG-LLE) Program is to provide funding to units of local law enforcement and tribal governments for the purchase of equipment. The funding is provided through the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), U.S. Department of Justice.

Jurisdictions are eligible for funding under the JAG-LLE grant because they have submitted Part 1 Violent Crime UCR data directly to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) under their own ORI number for at least 3 of the last 10 years for which UCR data is available, and meet the minimum threshold for the amount of Part 1 crimes committed in the federal year in which funding is being made available.
