2016 Sexual Assault Services Program Grant Awards

The purpose of the Sexual Assault Services Program Grant is to provide intervention, advocacy, accompaniment, support services, and related assistance for adult, youth, and child victims of sexual assault, family and household members of victims, and those collaterally affected by sexual assault, except for the perpetrator of such victimization. Examples of eligible services may include: crisis intervention, accompaniment to court, individual and group support services, information and referral, and the development and dissemination of materials.

<i>Grant funds will be used for a licensed mental health professional with experience in treating sexual assault victims, to provide trauma focused individual/group treatment to adults, adolescents, and children who are victims of sexual violence. This professional will also work with the rural underserved population, within a 5-county radius, including the Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgendered, Questioning, (GLBTQ) community, tribal communities, and the aging.</i>		
Women’s Resource Center, Inc.	Norman	\$31,450.50
<i>Grant funds will be used for an advocate that will provide crisis intervention, court advocacy, follow up services, respond to sexual assault calls, and outreach. Funds will also be used for a part-time sexual violence counselor that will provide individual and group therapy.</i>
