The Victim Services Roundtable, originally created by the District Attorneys Council as an ongoing Native American outreach initiative, brings together victim service providers, law enforcement, and prosecutors from local, state, tribal, federal, and non-government agencies. The overall goal of the roundtable discussion is to facilitate open communication, coordination, and collaboration in our effort to provide comprehensive services to victims of crime in our communities.

The roundtable has been approved by CLEET for 2 hours of mental health training for law enforcement. Training hours and mileage reimbursement has been approved for Victim Witness Coordinators who attend from District Attorney's offices.
