KAY COUNTY District Attorney Brian Hermanson and Ponca City Police Chief Don Bohon took part in a press conference Thursday as part of the Anti-Smurfing Public Awareness Campaign. Smurfing is the criminal practice of purchasing cold and allergy medicines containing pseudoephedrine to sell to someone who makes meth. Hermanson and Bohon highlighted the progress made in the war on meth. Hermanson called illegal drugs a serious problem and said 80 percent of the crimes committed in Kay County are related to drugs or alcohol. Bohon said those who choose to endeavor in meth endanger the community. "If we keep doing what we are doing we are going to find success," said Bohon. Gary Bintz, Bintz Pharmacy, said the store offers educational literature on the subject.
