INTERVIEWING

THIS CLASS WILL COVER INTERVIEW TECHNIQUES, HEARSAY EXCEPTIONS, AND REPORT WRITING TECHNIQUES USED FOR PRESENTATION TO PROSECUTION. IT WILL INCLUDE TECHNIQUES FOR INTERVIEWING CHILDREN AND WAYS TO BETTER INTERVIEW VICTIMS.

EVIDENCE COLLECTION

THIS CLASS WILL COVER WAYS TO PROCESS AND COLLECT EVIDENCE IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES. IT WILL DISCUSS PHOTOGRAPHY TECHNIQUES AND THE IMPORTANCE OF FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATIONS. THERE WILL ALSO BE A SECTION ON INJURY PHOTOGRAPHY. CAMERAS ARE NOT MANDATORY FOR THIS CLASS BUT IF YOU BRING A CAMERA USED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF YOU JOB, TECHNIQUES FOR IMPROVING YOUR PHOTOGRAPHIC SKILLS WILL BE DISCUSSED.
