REQUIREMENTS FOR CDSVRP

- The Committee shall authorize the issuance of a certificate to persons who qualify as follows:
- Has completed 1040 hours of work in a certified domestic violence/sexual assault/stalking program or comparable field such as criminal justice, trauma, substance abuse, etc. prior to applying for the CDSVRP course,
- Be sponsored by a domestic violence/sexual assault program that is certified by the Office of the Attorney General.
- Has completed the CDSVRP course satisfactorily,
- Has passed the exam provided, with a minimum score of 85%, as part of the course process; if the exam is not passed with a score of at least 85%, the candidate will be required to complete the course again with full fees, and pass the exam with a minimum of 85% to be considered for certification,
- Completion of two evaluations after finishing the course and passing the exam: the first after 520 hours, which is equivalent to three (3) months of full-time work/volunteering, or six (6) months of part-time work/volunteering. The second evaluation will occur after an accumulation of 1040 hours, which is equivalent to six (6) months full-time work/volunteering, or one (1) year part-time work/volunteering during the supervision experience,
- Be of good moral character.
- Must have access to internet & front-facing camera

- Must request excusal if you are unable to attend all sessions
- Under special circumstances makeup sessions may be completed within 30 days of training
