The Digital Photography For Law Enforcement Level 1 (DPLE 1) is an introductory digital photography course developed for law enforcement first responders and criminal investigators, who are responsible for photographically documenting crime scenes, traffic accident scenes, injuries, or any other type of evidence associated with a criminal investigation.

All camera equipment needed during the program is provided to the students:

- **Digital Single Lens Reflex Camera System - Nikon**
- **Flash**
- **Tripod**
- **Filters**
- **Scales/Markers**
- **Laptop with Digital Imaging Software Package**

Upon completion of the program the Camera System including flash and filters (included in program cost) is provided to the student and issued to their agency.
