

VOCA SUBGRANTEE AWARD RESULTS

The nine-member VOCA Board met on May 9, 2007 to approve the following grant awards. Due to a reduction of \$300,200.00 in funding from the Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime, the VOCA Board made the decision to only fund personnel and benefits, plus some consultant/contractor costs.

The Board realizes the hardship cuts may have on programs which have relied on funding for travel and other expenses; however, members believed it was critical to try and keep core personnel services intact in order to reduce the disruption in services programs may experience as a result of the cuts.

In addition to cutting many existing programs, the VOCA Board was unable to fund new programs and/or services.

We are hopeful that changes to federal legislation will eventually allow the VOCA cap to be eliminated, which would result in funding increases for programs in Oklahoma.
