Intimate Partner Terrorism

Training description: An 8 hour interactive training that takes a deeper look at the dynamics of domestic violence. In this training attendees will be given information on the domestic abuse behavior called “coercive control.” Coercive Control includes a myriad of tactics and behaviors that are utilized by perpetrators to gain and maintain power and control in an abusive relationship, often not leaving any physical marks, but the damage done is described many times as more deadly and damaging. Also in this training attendees will be given information about *Sexual Assault* and *Stalking* dynamics also found in *Intimate Partner Terrorism*. The final portion of the training will address officer safety issues and dynamics.
